- ii) A colour blind person shall not be eligible for recruitment. If a person is found to be colour blind at any stage of service career, he/she shall be boarded out as per SHAPE policy in vogue.
- iii) The candidate must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose veins or squint in eyes:
- iv) Must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any medical condition or physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties or a cause of rejection as per the revised Medical Guidelines issued by MHA from time to time.

- b) Eligible and interested candidate should apply only through BSF Recruitment website https://rectt.bsf.gov.in Candidate are advised to fill the application form after reading the instructions carefully. The application must be submitted ONLINE only. No application will be accepted offline. Candidature of the candidate who submitted application offline will be rejected summarily.



- c) The candidate has to upload copy of certificate or document for sports discipline mentioned at Para 2(a) above on BSF Recruitment Website in support of his/her highest medal/position or highest level of participation in the sports achievement mentioned at Para 4(b) on BSF Recruitment website in their profile created on the https://rectt.bsf gov.in before applying for the post, else his/her online application will be rejected during scrutiny.
- d) APPLICATION FEE & MODE OF PAYMENT- Male candidates belonging to General (UR) and OBC category applying for recruitment to the post of Constable (GD) under Sports quota should pay Rs. 159/- (Rupees One Hundred Fifty Nine) only as application fee through the BSF Recruitment website https://rectt.bsf.gov.in Application received with any other mode of fee payment will be summarily rejected. Fees is exempted for females and candidates belonging to Schedule Caste and Scheduled Tribe category.

Note-

- 6. No TA/DA will be admissible— No TA/DA or other expenses for appearing for the recruitment test will be paid to the candidates. The candidate should come duly prepared for more than 01-day stay under their own arrangement for the recruitment.

7. Selection Process-

Online application forms and copy of certificate uploaded by the candidates will be scrutinized and if found in order the candidates securing minimum qualifying 12 marks (for all category UR/SC/ST/OBC) and as per para 4b(iii) will be issued online admit cards to appear in the recruitment process i.e. Physical verification of Documents, Physical Standard Test (PST), and Detailed Medical Examination by the Recruiting Agency. Candidate will have to undergo the following process of recruitment-

(i) Documentation-

- a) Before start of documentation all candidates will undergo verification of identity including Biometric capture. Biometric identification of candidate can also be taken at any stage of recruitment.
- b) All candidates reporting for recruitment will have to go through documentation, in which candidates will have to produce all original documents/certificates pertaining to age, education, caste, sport achievement as per Para 4(b), proof to avail age and height relaxation etc. in the prescribed format before the Recruitment Board including the documents already uploaded on BSF recruitment website. The original documents (Educational, Sports, Domicile and Caste Certificates etc.) of the candidates will be checked by the recruitment board.



- c) After scrutiny of the original documents and sports certificate to the satisfaction of the Recruitment Board, the candidates whose documents are found in order will be asked to submit self-attested copies of the documents/sports certificate to the Recruitment Board on the spot. Original documents will be returned. BSF at its discretion can check or verify genuineness of any document/certificate produced by the candidate during recruitment and the decision of BSF after such verification/checking shall be final.
- d) Players who have participated or won medal(s) in the competitions given at para 4(b) above during the period from 04/11/2023 till 04/11/2025 shall be eligible for recruitment to the post of Constable/GD (Sportsperson) in BSF.
- e) Candidates will be given marks for medals won or level of participation during aforementioned time period only.
- f) Only the marks of that one higher medal/position or level of participation in which a candidate is getting maximum marks as per table given at Para 4(b) will be considered.
- g) If any candidate has secured more than 1 medal in a particular competition, in that case he/she shall be awarded marks for (only one) highest medal/position secured in the competition.
- h) Candidates who are unable to produce the prescribed certificate/documents will be rejected summarily and candidates who are declared qualified at documentation stage will be sent for Physical Standard Test (PST).
- i) OBC (NCL) certificate as per Annexure- IV, Scheduled Caste (SC)/ Scheduled Tribe (ST) certificate as per Annexure-III. Certificates obtained in any other format will not be accepted. Candidates claiming OBC status may note that certificate on Non Creamy Layers status as per Annexure-IV(A) should have been obtained within one year before the closing date of the online application.
- j) Candidates seeking relaxation as OBC (NCL) shall submit a declaration as Annexure-IV(A).
- k) Persons serving in Government services applying for the post are required to furnish No Objection Certificate (N.O.C.), as per Annexure-II issued by their employer at the time of physical verification of documents. Candidates who fail to submit No Objection Certificate (NO.C.) at the time of documentation shall be summarily rejected.
- Certificate as per Annexure 'V' for claiming relaxation in height & chest (if applicable).
- m) Domicile Certificate issued by local revenue authorities or PAN Card or Aadhar Card or Driving License or Voter ID Card or Passport for verification of citizenship. In case of West Pakistani Refugees settled in UT of Jammu & Kashmir and UT of Ladakh, they are required to produce Certificate in the format attached as Annexure- V issued by the Sarpanch/ Numbardar of a candidate's village to the effect that the person belongs to the West





Pakistani Refugees category, along with a copy of Electoral Roll showing the name of the candidate in the voter list for elections to the parliamentary constituency.

n) Four latest passport size photographs same as uploaded with online application form, to be submitted during documentation.

(ii) Physical Standard Test (PST):-

- a) Candidates who qualify in documentation will undergo PST as per the standard mentioned at Para 4(c) above.
- b) Candidate seeking relaxation in height and chest will be required to submit the certificate as per Annexure-V regarding their community from concerned District Authorities. In the event of non-enclosure of the certificate, their claim for relaxation in height and chest shall not be entertained.
- c) Those candidates who do not meet the required physical measurement at PST or DME stage will be eliminated from the recruitment process.
- d) On reporting of female candidates for Physical Standard Test (PST), a self-declaration indicating about her pregnancy status shall be submitted. In case, if she declares that she is not pregnant then, she will be allowed to participate in the PST. In case of false declaration, all the risk for undergoing PST will be of her own.
- e) If the female candidate declares that she is pregnant before PST, then a confirmatory pregnancy test is to be done and in case she is found to be pregnant, irrespective of duration of pregnancy, she will be declared temporary unfit and her appointment shall be held in abeyance until the confinement period is over. The vacancy against which a women candidate was selected will be kept reserved for her. She will be re-examined for PST six weeks after the date of confinement, subject to the production of the medical certificate of fitness from a registered medical practitioner. If she is found fit, she will be appointed to the post kept reserved for and allow the benefit of seniority in accordance with the instructions of the Government, as amended from time to time. In case female candidates is found negative for pregnancy, she will be allowed to participate in the PST. However, female candidates who is declared temporary unfit have to appear and qualify PST and DME/RME and have to secure place in final selection list of respective discipline/event.

(iii) Merit List-

- a) After completion of Documentation process and Physical Standard Test, Merit List will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate as per table given at Para 4(b) (III) in the advertised sports disciplines.
- b) The candidate shall be shortlisted for Detailed Medical Examination (DME) on the basis of merit. Tie will be resolved as under
 - i) Candidate securing highest marks will be placed higher in the merit list.
 - ii) If the candidate appearing for the recruitment having similar achievements in International competition than achievement in National competition will be considered for breaking tie (candidate with higher achievement in the National competition will be placed higher in merit).



- iii) If candidates appearing for recruitment have similar achievements in national level competitions, the tie will be broken based on the level of achievement: candidates with achievements in the National Games will be placed higher, followed by those in the Senior National Championship, and then the National Open Championship.

(iv) Detailed Medical Examination (DME): Candidates selected in order of merit as per number of vacancies will be put through DME to assess their fitness as per the medical guidelines issued from time to time by MHA.

(v) Appeal against Detailed Medical Examination: -

(A)

- a) A candidate declared unfit in detailed medical examinations, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officers, can submit an appeal for his/ her re-medical examination along with a Medical Fitness Certificate as per Annexure-'VI', as a piece of evidence about the possibility of an error of judgment in the decisions of the Medical Officer.
- b) The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment by a Medical Officer.
- c) The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains Medical Re-Examination fee of Rs. 25/- through Indian Postal Order in the name of Recruiting Agency and rejection slip (in original) issued by the Presiding Officers.
