- F.** The candidates recruited in level-1 (Erstwhile Group-D) posts will be appointed/posted in Izzatnagar Division, Lucknow Division, Varanasi Division, Mechanical Workshop/Gorakhpur and Headquarters/Gorakhpur/NER, for which they have applied according to their playing position.
- 2. SPORTS NORMS FOR RECRUITMENT:** - The minimum sports norms for recruitment of sportspersons against Sports Quota through Open Advertisement in different Grade Pay and Pay Bands for both team and individual events shall be as under. 3. Additional acceptable Sports achievement eligibility norms for Specific Sports disciplines only:

3.1 Athletics:

- 3.1.1** In Athletics, Medal winning performance in National Inter State Senior Athletics Championship, may also be considered for recruitment against the posts having GP-1900 in pay band Rs. 5200-20200.
- 3.1.2** In Athletics, Gold Medal winner in Open National Championships (Senior), Inter State Athletics Championship (Senior) and Asian Championships (Senior) may be Considered for recruitment in GP-2400/2800.

3.2 Cricket: In Cricket, following achievements may also be considered for recruitment in-

3.3 Hockey (Men):

3.3.1 In Hockey (Men), for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay-1900/2000 in Pay Band Rs. 5200-20200, participation in the International Tournaments (Senior or Junior) of four or more nations, may also be considered.

3.3.2 In Hockey (Men), Semifinalist in Senior National Championships may also be considered for Grade Pay-1900/2000 in Pay Band Rs. 5200-20200.

3.4 Hockey (Women): In Hockey (Women), for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay-1900/2000 in Pay Band Rs. 5200-20200; at least 2nd position in the International Tournaments of four or more nations, may also be considered. Participation in these tournaments may be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay-1800 in pay band Rs. 5200-20200.

“Hockey India” may be treated as the Recognised National Sports Federation for the Game of Hockey for the purpose of recruitment.

Note:

- A. All the recruitment shall be at the minimum of the Scale of pay.
- B. All the Championships mentioned above should have been conducted under the aegis of recognized International/National/State Sports Federation and also recognized by RSPB.
- C. For recruitment of sportspersons, on the basis of sports achievements in Junior National Championships, the age groups as mentioned below will only be considered:

4. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

(A) For the post having GP-1800: Matriculation (10th pass) **OR** ITI or its equivalent **OR** National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT.

(B) For the posts having GP-1900/2000: Pass in 10+2 or its equivalent **OR** Matriculation (10th Pass)/SSLC **plus** ITI in relevant trade (Recognised by NCVT/SCVT) **OR** Matriculation (10th Pass)/SSLC **plus** Course Completed Act Apprenticeship in relevant trade.

(C) For the post having GP-2400/2800: A university Degree or its equivalent.

5. **AGE:** 18-25 years as on 01.01.2026. Candidates born between 02/01/2001 and 01/01/2008 (both days inclusive) should only apply. No age relaxation is permissible
6. **PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:** The sports achievements of current & previous two financial years will be taken into account for eligibility. Therefore, the sports achievements on or after 01.04.2023 till the date of application will only be considered. For this purpose, concluding day of the championship shall be taken into account.
7. **HOW TO APPLY:** The link for online application is available at North Eastern Railway's website www.ner.indianrailways.gov.in. Candidate should carefully read all the instructions given in the Employment Notice before filling the online application form. Online application form should be filled following the step-by-step procedure given on the webpage. All the required fields must be filled-up carefully. Candidates must upload his/her scanned recent photograph, signature and all relevant mark sheets/certificates at the prescribed place while filling the application form.

8. EXAMINATION FEE:

For candidates belonging to SC, ST, Ex-Servicemen, Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD), Women, Minorities and Economically Backward Classes	Rs. 250	Refund of Rs.250 will be made to the candidates who actually appear in the trial.
All other candidates	Rs. 500	Refund of Rs.400 will be made to the candidates who actually appear in the trial.

The requisite examination fee should be deposited online as provided on the webpage of the online application form. After depositing the examination fee, the candidates should login again and must take a printout of the application form.

9. MODE OF SELECTION & RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The recruitment will be based on the performance in trial and evaluation of sports and educational achievements.

9.1 All eligible candidates will be called for trial and after trial, only the FIT candidates (**securing 25 or more, out of 40 marks for Game skill, physical fitness and coach's observations during trial**) shall be assessed for next stage of recruitment. Candidates declared NOT FIT will not be assessed further.

9.3 Minimum qualifying marks for recruitment through Open Advertisement Sports Quota for post in Level-4/5, Level-2/3 & Level-1 is as follows:

Note: The offer of appointment shall be given purely on the basis of merit. In case more than one sportsperson score the same marks, preference will be given to younger candidate to decide the merit.

10. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT:

- (A) Before applying, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility norms.
- (B) The specific position played in the particular game/event, if applicable, must be mentioned in the application form.
- (C) The Educational or Sports qualifications acquired after the date of application shall not be considered.
- (D) Candidates furnishing false information/suppressing the facts will be disqualified and shall be liable for debarment and legal action. Candidates who attempt fraud/impersonation are liable for debarment to appear in the future examinations conducted for recruitment in Railways.
- (E) Candidates found eligible for appointment have to pass the prescribed medical examination conducted by the Railway Administration before appointment.
- (F) Mere fulfilling minimum eligibility criteria for recruitment or selection of candidates and recommendation for their appointment shall not confer any right on the candidates for their appointment in Railway.
- (G) Second Class free journey pass from the nearest Railway Station mentioned in the application form will be issued to the candidates belonging to SC & ST communities whenever they are called at any stage of recruitment.
- (H) The person appointed against Sports Quota in the category of clerks will be required to possess proficiency in typing within a period of four years from the date of appointment. If the candidate does not acquire prescribed typing qualification within the stipulated period, increments due after four years and thereafter shall not be released.
- (I) Candidates should be in readiness to appear in the trials at a very short notice.
- (J) Railway Administration is not responsible for any delay or non- delivery of e-mail or SMS. Candidates should mandatorily visit the N. E. Railway's website www.ner.indianrailways.gov.in for regular updates.

Note:

- (A) In case of difference between English and Hindi versions of the Employment Notice the English version shall prevail.
- (B) The decision of RRC/NER in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, issue of the free journey pass, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of trial, trial venue, and all other matters related with recruitment process will be final and binding on the candidates. Any enquiry or correspondence will not be entertained in this connection.
- (C) Railway Administration will not be liable/responsible for any loss/injury/damage, whether direct or consequential, suffered/incurred by any candidates during the recruitment process.
- (D) Any legal issues arising out of or in connection with this employment notice shall fall within the legal jurisdiction of Central Administrative Tribunal, Allahabad.
