** Age relaxation will be admissible only to those employees working under Central Government not under Autonomous Body/State Government/PSU and working in posts which are in the same line or allied cadres and here a relationship could be established that the service already rendered in a particular post will be useful for the efficient discharge of duties of the post(s) to which has been advertised. Decision in the regard will rest with the authority of AIIMS, Madurai.*

13. **No age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates applying for unreserved vacancies.**

14. The persons belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD must submit the certificate in the requisite proforma duly issued by the authority concerned (**if applicable**). Reservation and/or Relaxation to SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD/Ex-SM shall be admissible to respective category candidates as per the Govt. of India rules.

(iii) Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe (SC/ST): Applicants are required to produce the necessary certificate as prescribed in M.H.A., O.M., No. 42/21/49-N.G.S. dated the 28.1.1952, as revised in Dept. of Per-& A.R. letter No. 36012/6/76-Estt.(SCT), dated the 29.10.1977, to be produced by candidate belonging to a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe in support of his/her claim.

(iv) Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD): The minimum degree of disability should be 40% (Benchmark Disability) in order to be eligible for availing reservation for persons with specified disability. 17. Decision of the competent authority of AIIMS, Madurai in all matters regarding eligibility/selection would be final and binding on all applicants/candidates. No correspondence whatsoever would be entertained by the AIIMS, Madurai in this regard.
